

### THE COMMUNITY

Tooele County begins 20 miles west of Salt Lake City, and stretches west to the Nevada state line and encompasses some 7,000 square miles of widely varying terrain. From 12,000 foot mountain peaks and alpine meadows to the stark beauty of salt flats, the

geography of Tooele County offers something for everyone.

Tooele has the small community feel, but being only 40 minutes from Utah's capitol Salt Lake City, has the amenities of big city life nearby. There is world class recreation within Utah's Wasatch Mountain ski resorts and the surrounding area. Salt Lake International Airport is located just 25 minutes away.



Population has increased substantially in the past decade, with 64,342 residents in the most recent count. The county includes the communities of Tooele, Grantsville, Erda, Stansbury Park, Lake Point, Stockton, Rush Valley, Vernon, Dugway, Ibapah and



Wendover. About 92 percent of the population of the county resides in the Tooele Valley.
