THE COMMUNITY

South Summit School District is located in the beautiful Kamas Valley at the base of the Uintah Mountains of northeast Utah. The district covers 1,372 square miles of which over 90% is located within the boundaries of the Wasatch National Forest. Kamas Valley is located approximately 50 miles east of Salt Lake City.

The district draws its students from several different communities located within the Kamas Valley which has a population of just over 7,000 residents. Historically the area has been known for its lumber industry as well as its many cattle and horse ranches. Because of its location next to two large reservoirs and the Wasatch National Forest it is now known for its many recreational opportunities. Residents can enjoy camping, fishing, boating, water skiing, snowmobiling, and snow skiing all within a fifteen-minute drive. Local celebrations and rodeos are also a major attraction for our communities.

The valley maintains its rural atmosphere with the advantage of being in close proximity to the Wasatch Front. Well maintained roads and freeways allow our citizens to be in the world famous Park City Ski Resort area within fifteen minutes and to downtown Provo or Salt Lake City in less than an hour.

THE DISTRICT

There are many outstanding programs, both academic and activity centered for students and families in the South Summit School District. Professional Learning Communities and Response to Intervention programs are a major part of our continuing effort to provide the very best learning opportunities for our students. Our facilities are well maintained and up to date with technology. We are fortunate to have a one to one ratio of computers to students from grades three through twelve. South Summit will complete construction of a new district office-community learning center by June of this year.

The district maintains close ties with Utah Valley University. Additional educational opportunities are available at their Wasatch Campus a short ten minute drive from the valley.

We are very fortunate to own and operate the South Summit Aquatic and Fitness Center.

This modern facility has a lap pool, recreation pool, gymnasium, exercise rooms, weight lifting center and an indoor track. During summer months patrons also have availability to outdoor volleyball, tennis courts, and running track.
