Representative Brad Last represents House District 71 in southern Utah. He holds a B.S. and M.B.A. degree from the University of Utah and is the Vice-President for Development for Dixie State University. He has been serving in the Legislature since 2003. He is chair of Education and Interim Co-chair of Education with Senator Ann Milner. He served on the Washington County Board of Education from 1994 to 2002.



Representative V. Lowry Snow represents House District 74 in southern Utah. He holds a B.S. degree from BYU and a J.D. degree from Gonzaga University School of Law. He is an attorney. He has been serving in the Legislature since 2012. He serves on the Education Interim Committee and House Education Committee.



Senator Ann Milner represents Senate District 18 that encompasses Davis, Morgan, and Weber Counties. She holds a B.S. degree from the University of Tennessee, M.S. from Texas State University, and Ed. D. from BYU. She has taught and held various positions in university institutions including Vanderbilt, Thomas Jefferson University, and Southwest Texas State. In 1982 she joined Weber State University and held various positions there until she was named in 2002 as the 11th President of Weber State University, a position she held until 2012. Senator Milner is co-chair of the Education Interim, and Chair of Senate Education.
