The Beaver County School District has five campuses serving approximately 1530 students Pre-K through 12th grade. Each school utilizes I:I technology device initiatives and smart board technologies in classrooms. Google Classroom, CANVAS, strong reading & English-Language Arts programs, State championships in football, basketball, track, complements high Associate Degree completers.


Belknap Elementary is located in Beaver, Utah and serves approximately 490 students Pre-K through 6th grade. Belknap Elementary is one of the highest academic performing elementary schools in Utah and recently received state and national recognitions for their academic achievement. The school has participated in Utah's Beverly Taylor Sorensen Music and Arts program.

<u>Beaver High School</u> is located in Beaver, Utah and serves approximately 480 students 7th through 12th grades. Beaver High has averaged 20% Associate Degree completers the past five years. It is home to a strong sports environment having won 7 state championships over the last 5 years. There is a strong emphasis on academic excellence, and a strong CTE program. The high school is considered the life blood of the community and as such has strong support and high expectations in every facet of the high school program.

<u>Minersville School</u> is located in Minersville, Utah, 17 miles west of Beaver. The school serves approximately 120 students, K through 8th grade. Minersville School has a very strong academic heritage and has been recognized several times by the Utah State Board of Education and the Governor's Office. The Minersville 8th graders scored in the 85 percentiles on the 2018 Utah SAGE Assessment in Math and Science. Minersville School has participated in Utah's Beverly Taylor Sorensen Music and Arts program.

Milford Elementary School is located in Milford, Utah and is 30 miles west of Beaver. Milford Elementary serves approximately 235 students Pre-K through 6th grade. Milford is a diverse community that embraces the diversity that business like Union Pacific, Smithfield Foods, and renewal energy brings. Milford Elementary is a "Power in Me" school and a Beverley Taylor Sorensen Music and Arts program. Academics are a strong focus for Milford Elementary where the SAGE scores reflect the dedication and work of staff and students alike.

Milford High School is located in Milford, Utah 30 miles west of Beaver and is home to 230 students 7th through 12th grade. Milford High has an environment of strong teacher support with high expectations for all that has resulted in SAGE Growth scores raising faster than the state average. Milford is indicative of small, rural communities throughout the state where the school is a focal point of the community. The community is supportive of academics and of the 7 state championships, including Academic State Championship over the past five years.
