Each student learns in a safe and healthy school environment





Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP) 2021-2022: ACT Scores




## **KEEP Exit Criteria**




### **RISE ELA Percentage At or Above Proficiency**




### **RISE Mathematics Percentage At or Above Proficiency**


