Proposition 6

Amends the Utah Constitution to 1) establish the definition of "public education system" for purposes of authorizing the expenditure of the available interest from the State School Fund and revenues from the Uniform School Fund in support of the public education system; and 2) specify that the revenues from income tax or intangible property tax are to be used for the support of the higher education system in addition to the public education system.

(ii) provides a budgetary stabilization account;

[(5)] (c) to support children and to support individuals with a disability[.]; and

(d) to support other state needs after the fulfillment of the requirements in Subsection (5)(b).

HB394: Hold Harmless for Public Education Enrollment Decline

2023 Legislative Session Representative K. Peterson Statutorily guarantee, contingent on the passage of the constitutional amendment:

- C Legislature will fund additional increases to the WPU value by rolling in the savings in the minimum school program from declining enrollment for fiscal years 2026-2030.
- S Will sunset in 2030 unless legislature extends another five years.

HB394

2% WPU increase was set aside in 2023 and will be distributed after the 2024 election if the constitutional amendment passes.
